## Headlines

- 1. A lack of variety (involvement) when it comes to extra-curricular activities. An average of 48.4% said they didn't regularly take part in house activities. Especially in sixth form.
- 2. A2B. 34% of year 10 and 11 don't believe bullying is dealt with effectively. This is lower amongst other year groups but still not low enough.
- 3. Reading regularly in years 9,10 and 11 came back as 17%. We need to make reading appealing for the further 83%
- All year groups (yr7=64%, yr8 = 78%, yr9 73%, yr10 75%, yr11 75%, yr12, 67%, yr13 68% believe we could be doing more for the environment







**Extra- Curricular** – Friday Student Council meeting 1/2/19 solely focused on analyzing current clubs and organising tutor activity for following week in regards to what else students would like to be offered.
