Inviting a famous author into school

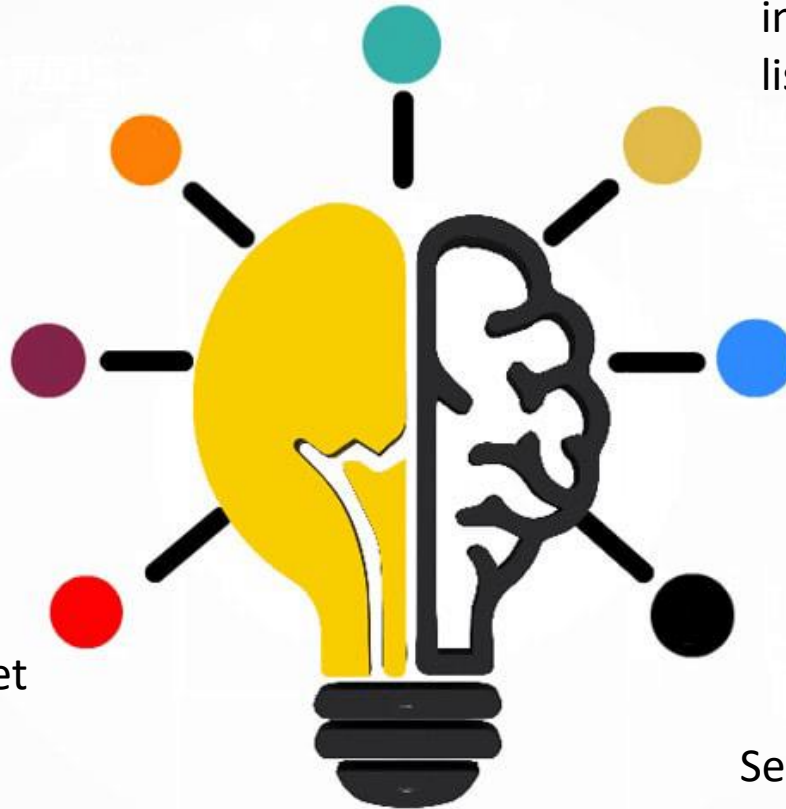
Book swap
